



Stefania Lucchetta

Short biography

Stefania Lucchetta was born and lives in Bassano del Grappa, Italy.

She holds degrees from Ca' Foscari University in Venice (1999, BA with honors in Literature and Art History) and Scuola Italiana Design in Padua (2004, Master degree in Industrial Design).

Already in 2000 – after acquiring a good knowledge of *moulded* jewellery, lost-wax casting, engraving and laser cut, and training in goldsmith art within her family business, she started focusing on 3D software and rapid prototyping machines. In 2002, exploring innovative techniques parallel to her industrial design collections, she launched her limited edition jewels using materials such as: polyamide, bio-compatible resins, stellite and titanium.

In 2007 she founded her own studio Stefania Lucchetta srl.

Thanks to her innovative research, she has been invited to give lectures at Milan Politecnico, and her works have been exhibited in important institutions worldwide, including the Kunstgewerbemuseum in Berlin (Germany), the Triennale in Milan (Italy), the Museum for Modern Art in Arnhem (Netherlands), the Yorkshire Sculpture Park in Wakefield (UK), the Museum of Arts and Design in New York (USA), the Museo del Gioiello in Vicenza (Italy). Also, her works have often been featured in design magazines and catalogues of contemporary artistic jewellery.

In November 2010 her work was ranked by leading magazine Wallpaper* among the “Top 20 reasons to be in Italy”.
